Accessibility- Silverado Park is accessible and comfortable to all guests.

Alcoholic Beverages- The Complex has a zero tolerance policy in regard to outside alcohol. Guest or players caught with or attempting to bring in outside alcohol will be removed from the Complex for the remainder of the day.

Animals- The Park is dog friendly. All dogs must have a valid rabies tag to enter. No other animals are permitted.

Admission- There are no ticket sales onsite.

Benches- Benches will be off limits for social distancing.

Bag Policy: No bag search.

Bicycles- Bicycles are allowed on the premises.

Broadcast- Games can be live streamed via facebook. Teams must provide video equipment.

C

Coaches- Coaches, Managers, and Little League Staff are required to testes for COVID19 and must show proof.

Capacity- 50 people are allowed at all three fields. The League Staff will keep an accurate head count.

Concessions- Pre-packaged food and beverages are available throughout the ballpark at several permanent locations. Contactless payments will be made available. Hand sanitizer will be made available at the Concession stand.

Chewing Tobacco- Chewing tobacco is prohibited on the playing field or any turfed areas.

Cleats- Athletes may wear molded cleats or other athletic shoes on the playing surface. Absolutely no metal cleats.

Code of Conduct— Coaches, players and fans all must abide by the Little League rules and bylaws at all times. Any guests found violation of Code of Conduct may be removed from the premises.

Coolers- No team coolers or team snack after the games.

Credentials- Coaches may be provided credentials for entry to the field. Credentials must be shown while on the field.

D

Drugs- Silverado Little League has a zero tolerance policy for any illegal substances found on the premises. Any persons found violating this policy will immediately be removed from the field by Law Enforcement.

Dugouts- Dugouts and bullpens are for athletes and coaches only.

Exit- Little League Staff will enforce teams and families to exit the field after games and practices are over.

Equipment- No sharing of equipment. The league will not provide equipment.

Emergency Evacuation- In the event of an emergency, listen for instructions form the League Officials.

F

Field Policy- Peanuts with shells, seeds and gum are strictly prohibited on or around the turf fields. Athletes may wear molded cleats or other athletic shoes on the playing surface. Absolutely no metal cleats. No tobacco products, sports drinks or liquids other than water will be allowed on the field.

Firearms/weapons- The Complex strictly prohibits weapons or firearms. Any violators will be escorted out of the facility.

Foul balls- The Field is an active baseball/softball park, for your safety, please be aware of balls flying in foul territory. If you retrieve a ball, please return it to the umpire. The ball will be cleaned before it is put back into play.

Field access- Credentialed coaches and athletes only are permitted on the fields

Food/beverage- The Park does allow any outside food or drinks into the Park.

Games- A 30 minute in between game will be permitted so the Little league staff and sanitize the dugouts.

Gum- Gum is not allowed during the game.

Handicap parking- In accordance with the ADA, disabled parking spaces are available at all entries into the Park.

Hand Sanitizer- Hand Sanitizer must be provided by the Coach.

High Fives- No high fives and post games handshakes.

Immediate Family- Immediate family is only allowed at the park.

Isolations areas- Designated areas will be located throughout the park.

Inclement weather- In the event of inclement weather, please listen to the league officials.

Janitorial Services- The Park will be cleaned throughout each event by Park Services.

Lost and Found- Lost and found is located inside the snack shack.

Lost children/guests- Lost children/guests will be escorted to the snack shack.

M

Mask- Masks are required at all times. The Little League will enforce this policy.

Merchandise- Merchandise is generally on sale at snack shack.

Music- Music can be played between innings and for walk up songs. Teams must provide their own music players.

New Game Balls- New game balls will be provided at the start of every new games.

Noise Makers- There are no noise-makers allowed during the games.

One Team- One team will enter the field at a time to avoid congestion.

Parents- Parents must disinfect players equipment after every use.

Pets- Pets are allowed and must be on leashes.

Parents- Parents and families must depart the park immediately after their game is over.

Ride share- No giving teammates ride home.

Restrooms- Restrooms are provided in all areas.

Rain/Weather delay- In the event of a weather delay please listen to PA announcements for instructions or visit the event website for updates.

Sanitizer- Purell, Clorox and Lysol will be used to clean and disinfect areas at the park.

Signs- Signage will be placed throughout the park that state practice social distancing and wash your hands. 6 feet apart sign will be located at the park.

Staff- Staff will be provided with training material on cleaning, sanitizing and disinfecting. Little League Staff will enforce COVID19 Policy.

Sunflower seeds- Sunflower seeds are not allowed during the games.
